1. Prohibited Users

- Any organization designated as a terrorist or extremist entity

Rowe AI does not provide services to these groups under any circumstances.

2. Prohibited Uses

Clients and end-users may not use Rowe AI for:

- Terrorist activity
- Extremist propaganda
- Money laundering
- Fraud or identity deception
- Evasion of sanctions
- Support of sanctioned individuals or organizations
- Any activity that violates Canadian or international law

3. Screening & Monitoring

Rowe AI may:

- Monitor usage for suspicious or high-risk activity
- Block IP addresses associated with sanctioned jurisdictions
- Suspend or terminate accounts suspected of sanctions violations
- Request additional verification from Clients if needed
- Report illegal activity to authorities when required by law

Rowe AI does not actively profile users but may take action when red flags appear.

4. Client Responsibilities

Clients agree to:

- Not use Rowe AI on behalf of sanctioned individuals or entities
- Not deploy the chatbot in prohibited jurisdictions
